<b>1. Strict stay-at-home policy for any student or staff member exhibiting symptoms.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Complete self-check DAILY.</li><li>-Provide information about pre-existing medical conditions (i.e. allergies).</li><li>-Communication with homeroom teachers (elementary) and check Google Classroom (junior high) for assignments and activities.</li></ul>	<b>2. Daily monitoring and screening of all staff and students.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Quarantine in office infirmary.</li><li>-Use of touchless thermometers if students are unwell, face shields and masks.</li><li>-Pick up by parent/guardian as soon as possible.</li></ul>
<b>3. Mandatory mask use for all staff and students from grades 4 to 9. Use in K-3 is optional.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Grades 4 to 9 students will be required to wear masks in all public spaces and can choose to wear them while seated in class.</li><li>-Plexiglass shields in front office, Success Coach and SLP spaces.</li></ul>	<b>4. Reorganization of rooms to allow for more physical distancing.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Area rugs and soft surface items have been removed.</li><li>-Band program will use the Dapp Community Hall as a larger space with barriers used.</li></ul>
<b>5. Co-horting of students by class and division</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-K to 2 and 3 to 6—staggered entrance and exit times for start and end of school, recess, and class transitions.</li><li>-Grades 7 to 9 students will be considered one cohort with staggered transition times and physical distancing where possible. CTF &amp; Intramural programs will be offered using outside spaces where possible and no sharing of supplies.</li></ul>	<b>6. Enhanced Cleaning &amp; Disinfecting</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Midday cleaning by PHSD Custodian.</li><li>-Deep cleaning after hours.</li><li>-Disinfecting fogger for common spaces (i.e. Music room).</li></ul>
<b>7. Guided flow of foot traffic through entrances and hallways</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Recess and class changes will be staggered.</li><li>-Stay to the right.</li><li>-Use of outside routes for Music class as weather permits.</li></ul>	<b>8. No Sharing</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Each student will have their own supplies. (K-2 teachers will still purchase and provide individual kits).</li><li>-Quarantining of library and classroom books after use.</li><li>-Where sharing of equipment is required, it will be cleaned between uses (i.e. PE or Science Equipment).</li></ul>
<b>9. Water Fountains &amp; Microwaves</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Water fountains will be closed. Bottle filling station will be open.</li><li>-Please send your child(ren) with additional water bottles.</li><li>-Staff will assist with bottle filling and microwave use.</li></ul>	<b>10. Hand Hygiene &amp; Respiratory Etiquette</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Continual reminders for washing hands, avoid touching face, covering coughs and sneezes.</li><li>-Hand sanitizer stations have been provided in addition to touchless faucets and additional paper towel dispensers.</li></ul>
