- We would like to definitely connect with all parents of Grade 9 students to discuss high school course selections

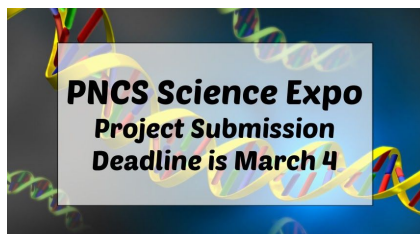


Teachers will be available on the following dates:

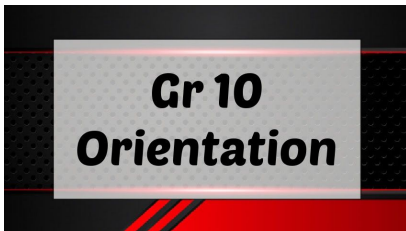
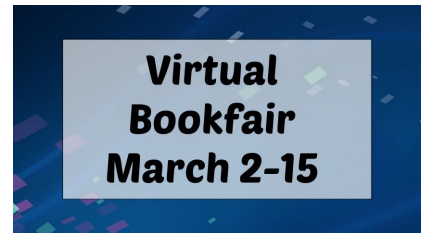
[Science Expo Project Deadline - March 4](#)

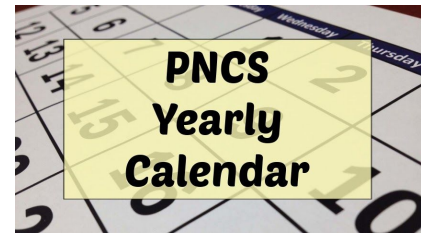
