- 5. Administration report- presented by Daryl Chattargoon. Daryl said that it has been an awesome start to the school year. There was a pancake breakfast with the board of trustees and staff which was great. The new Viewsonic displays have been set up in each classroom to replace the smartboards. There will be a meeting October 7th for the teachers to learn more about the boards and all the ways to use them. Enrollment has increased from 192 (last school year) to 197 (at the start of this school year). Heather Beaver has transitioned into her new supporting role and will be with Pembina North 4 half days per week. Kerry Vanderwekken is the new grade three teacher this year. Ann-Marie Carnegie is back teaching grade one. The fall CTF classes for junior high are as follows: beginner foods, fitness, drama, outdoor pursuits, games and art. There is no band because of low enrollment but they are looking into other ways to keep music at the junior high level.
