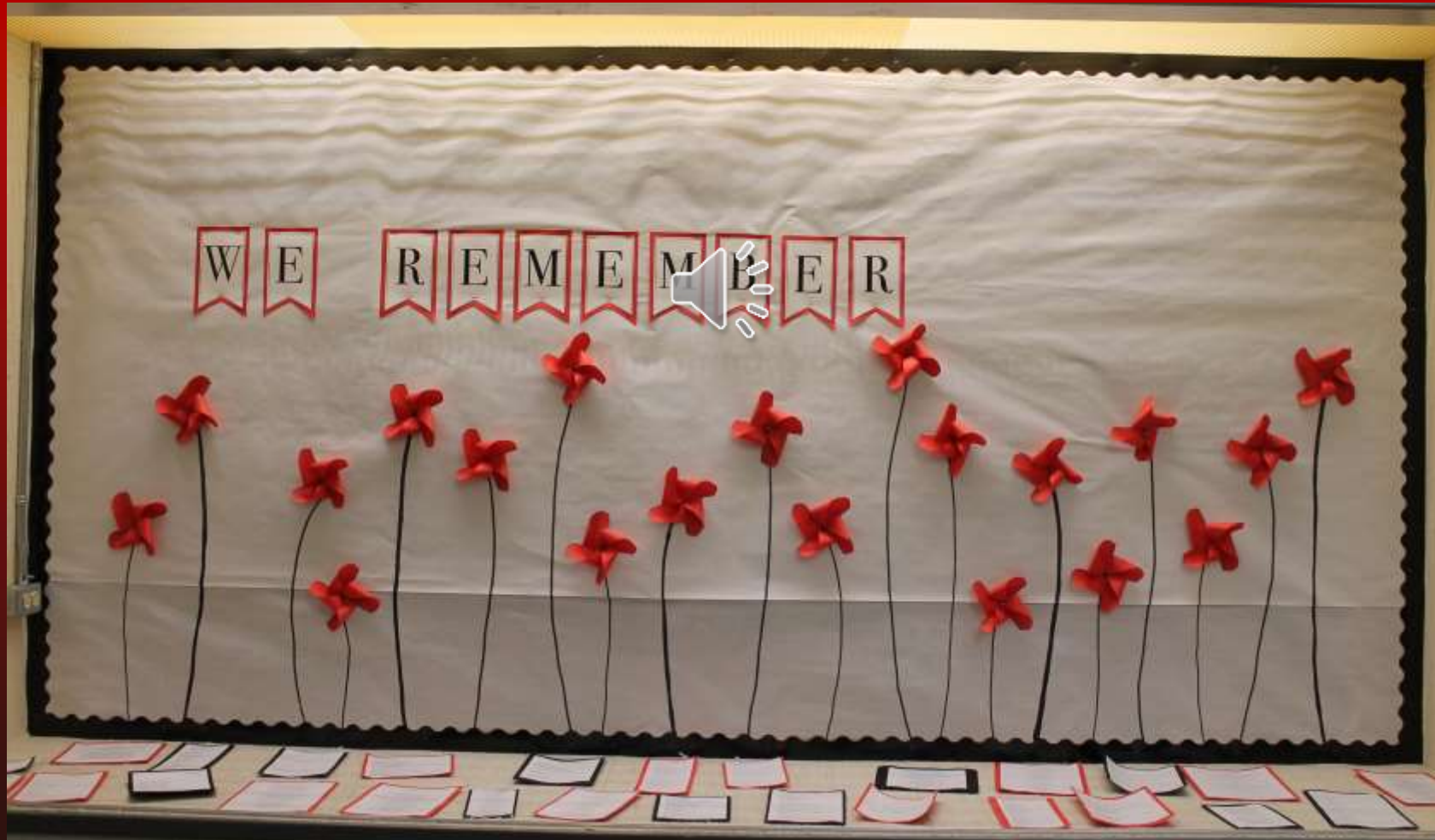

We shall not forget.





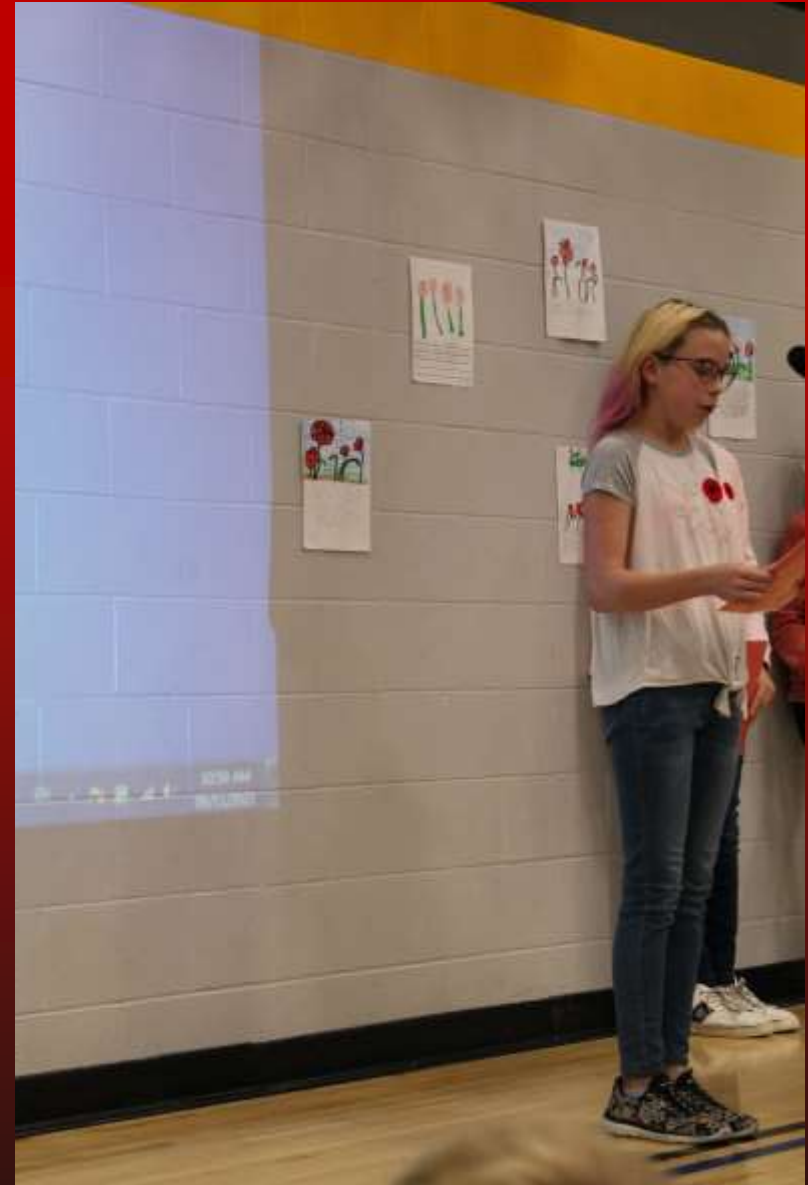










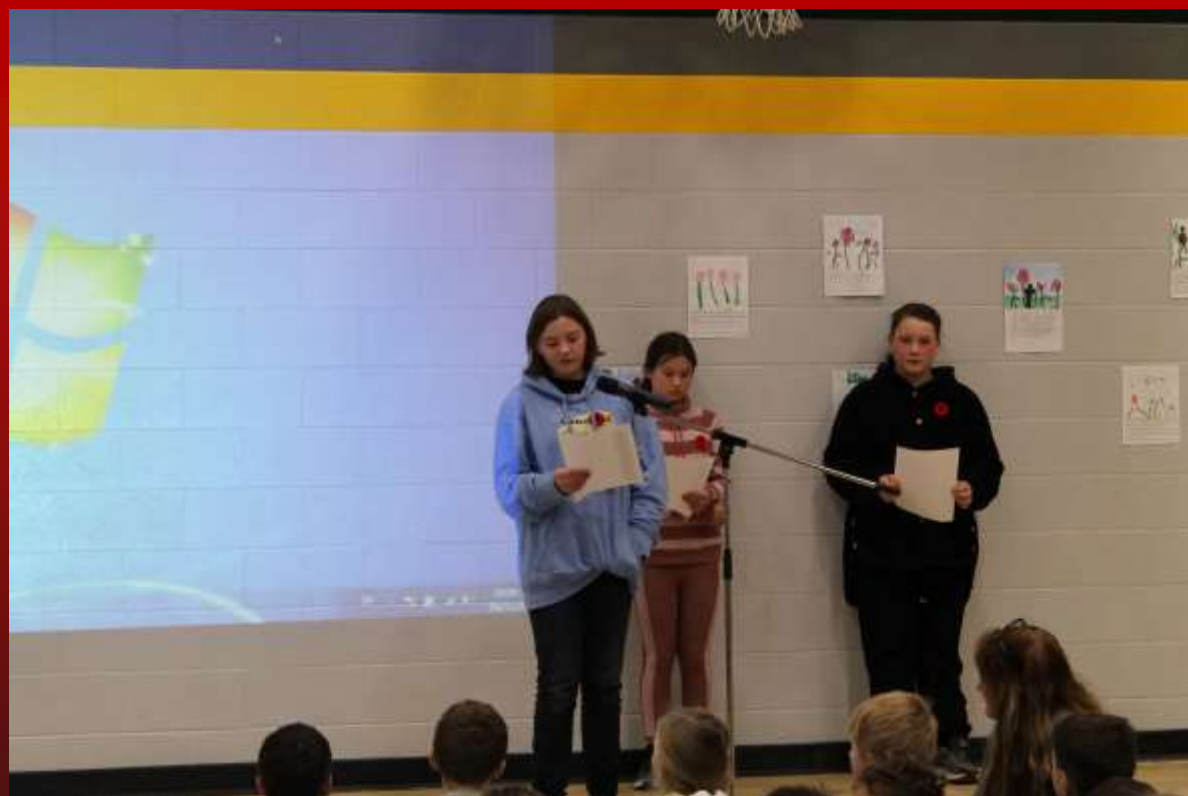










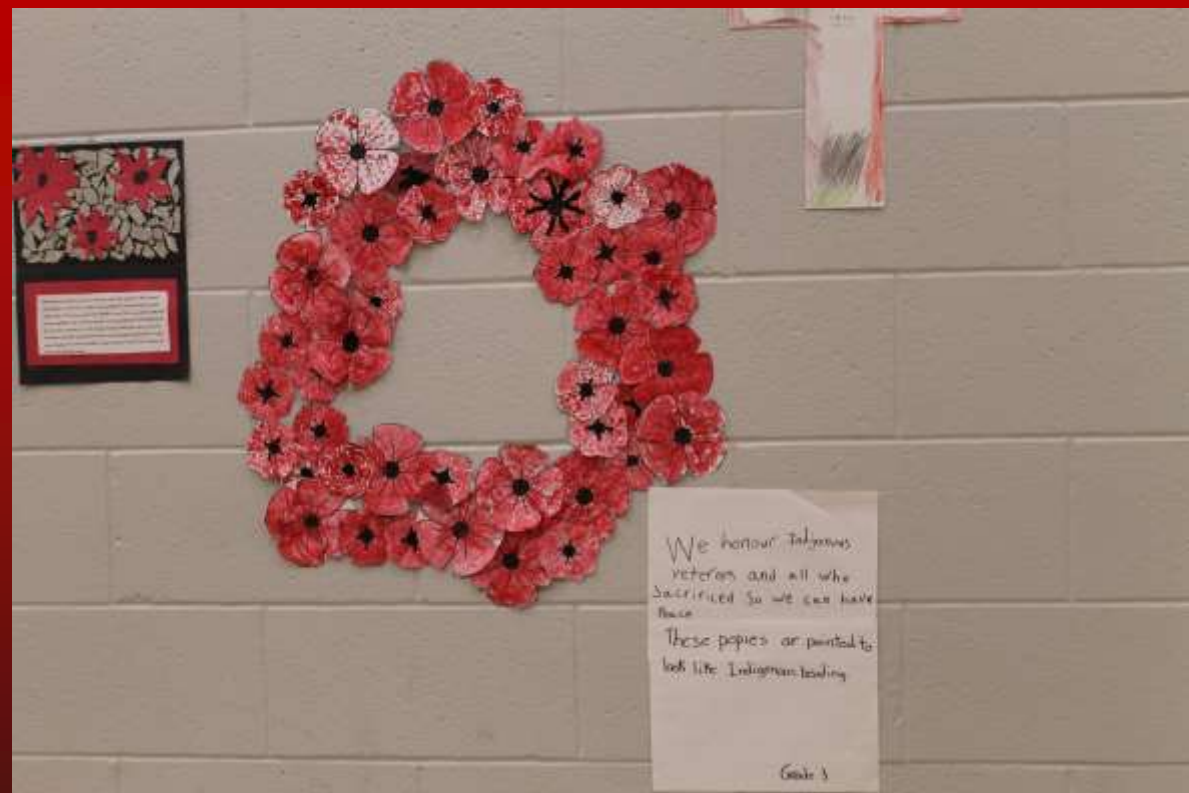








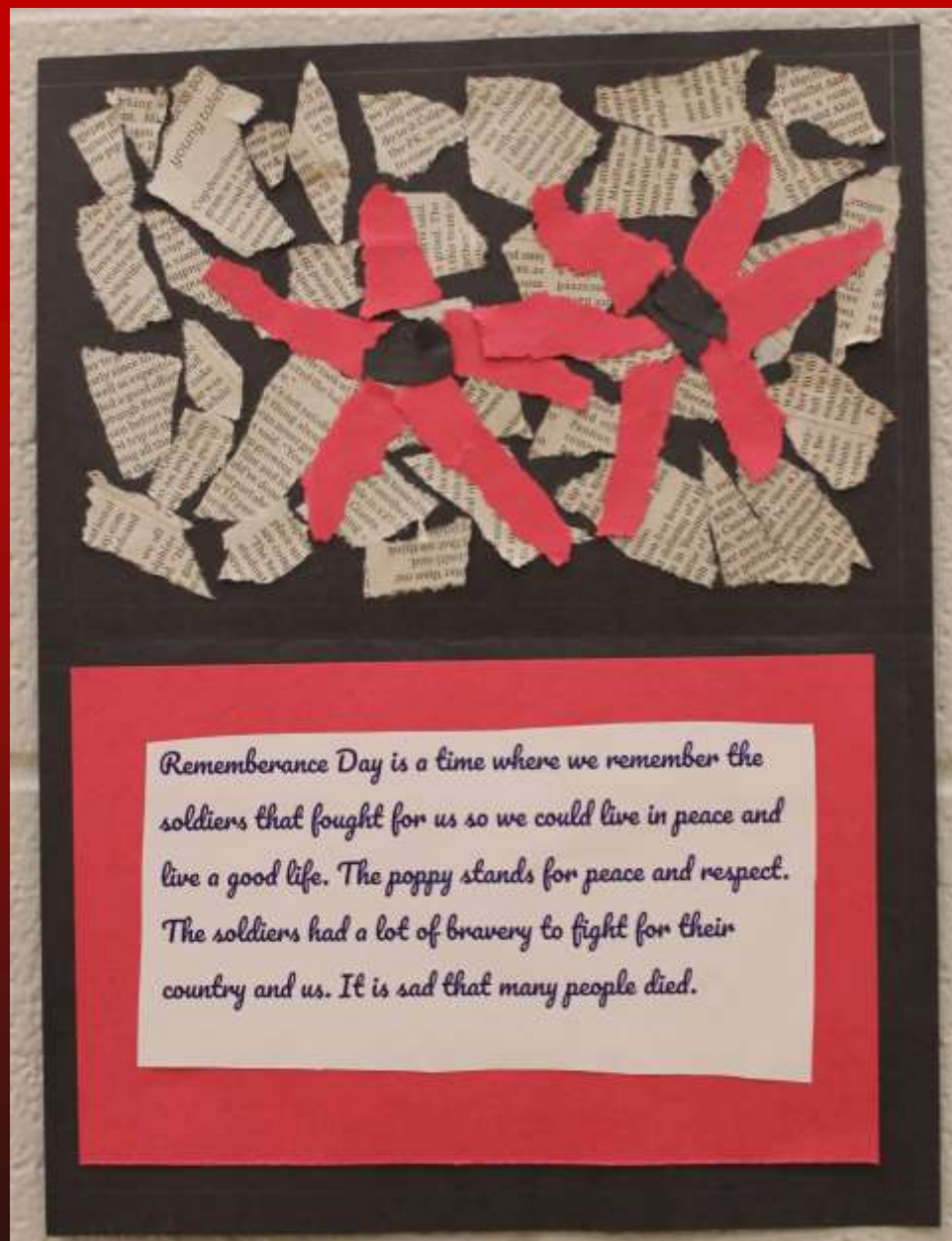


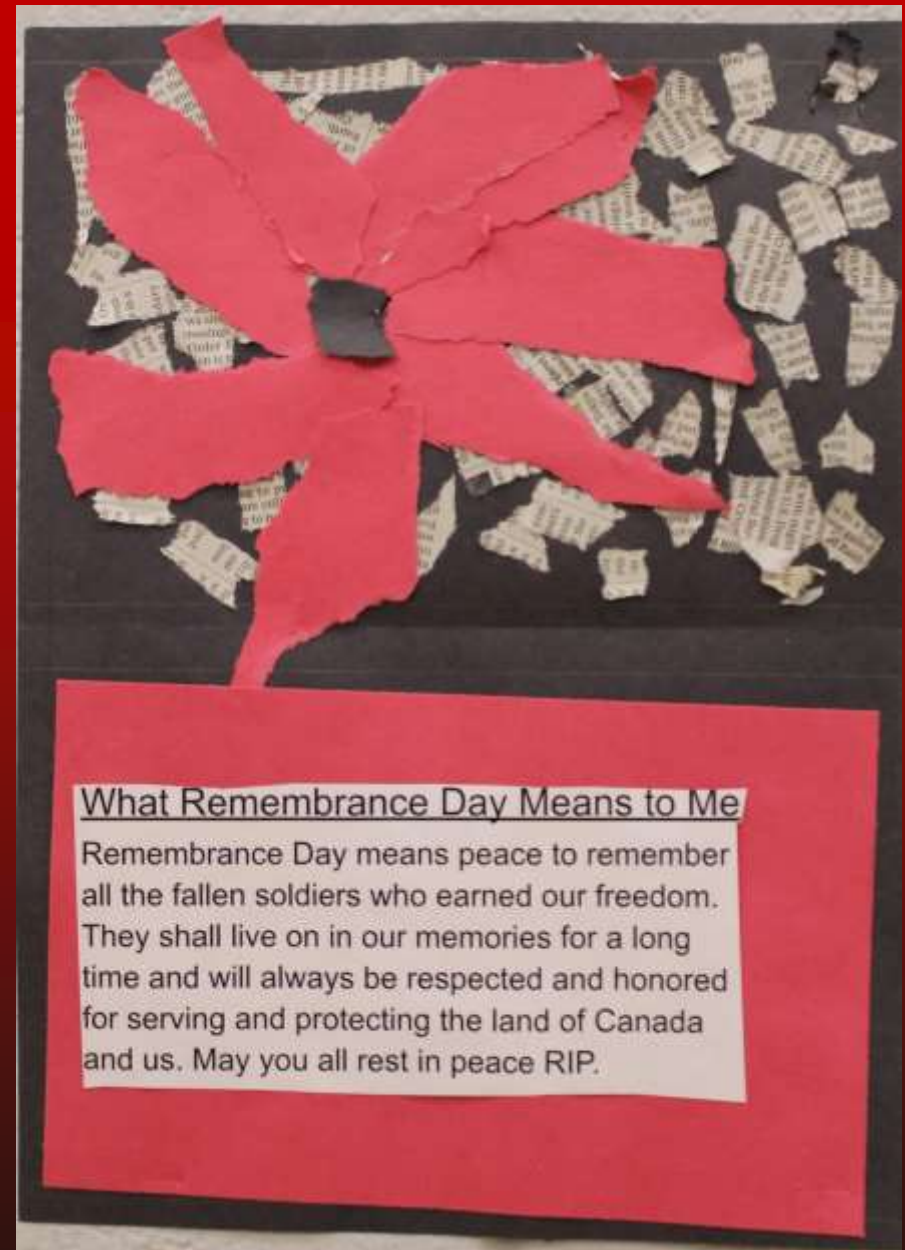


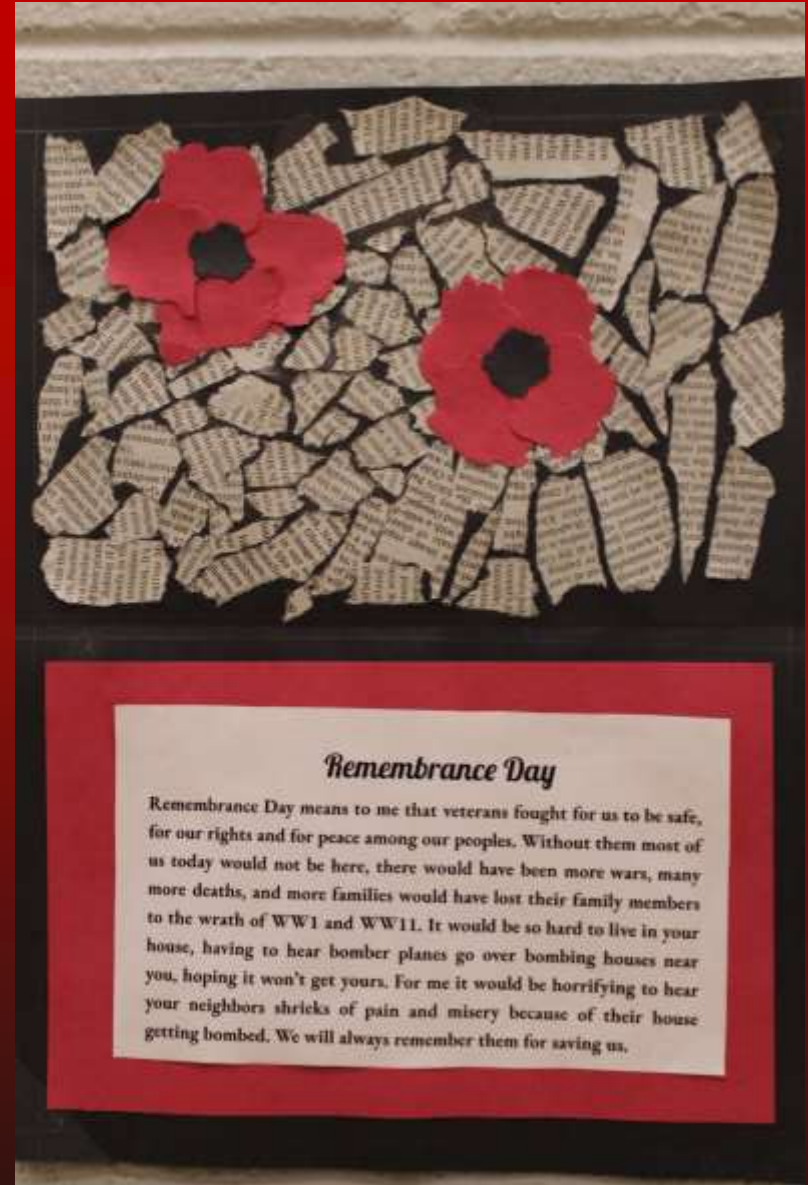
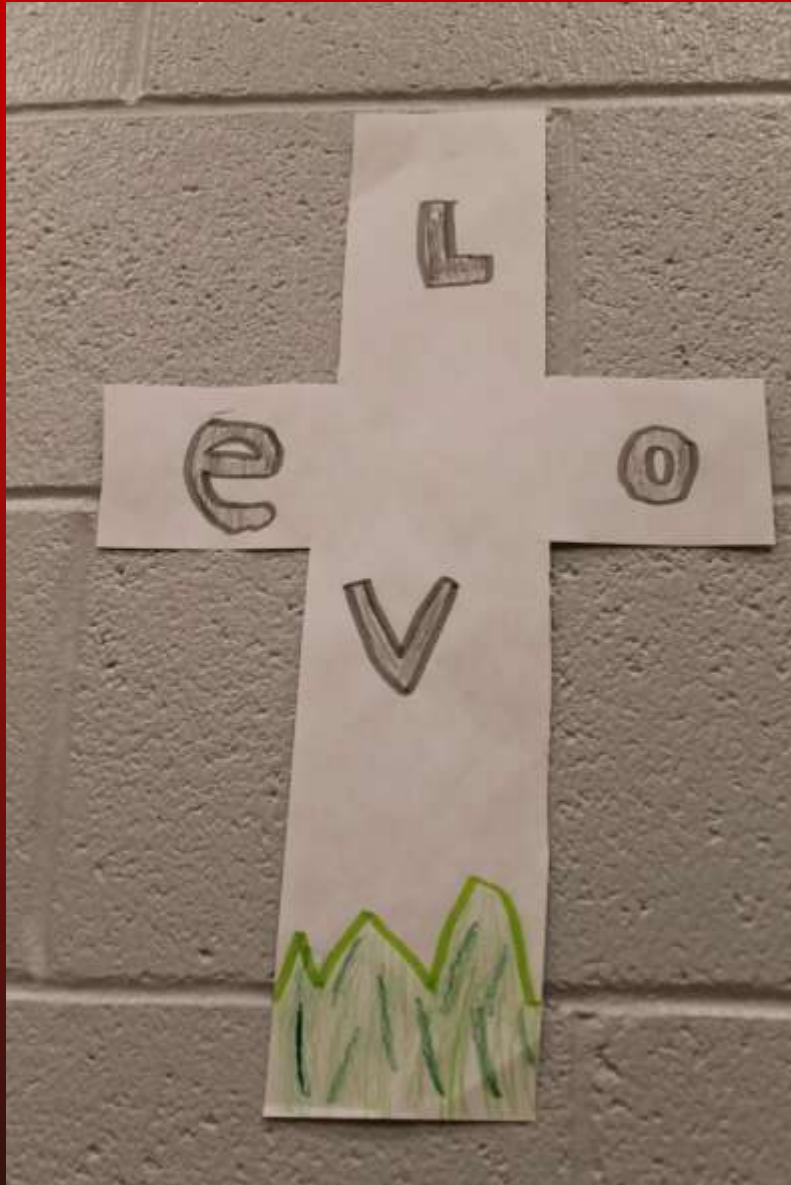

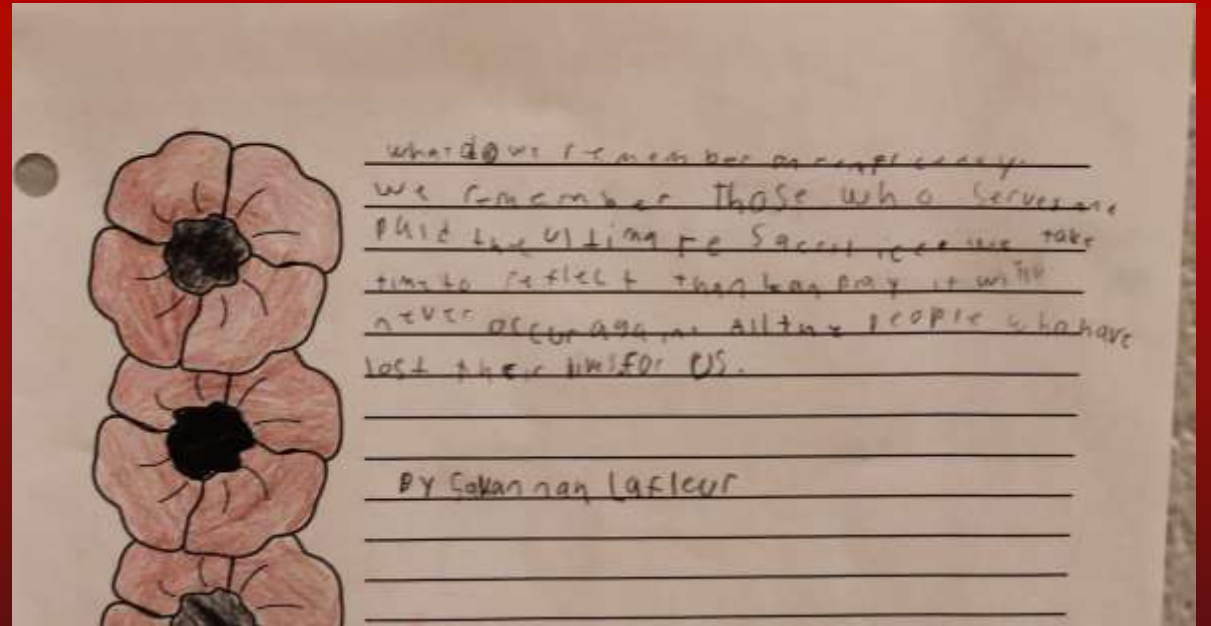
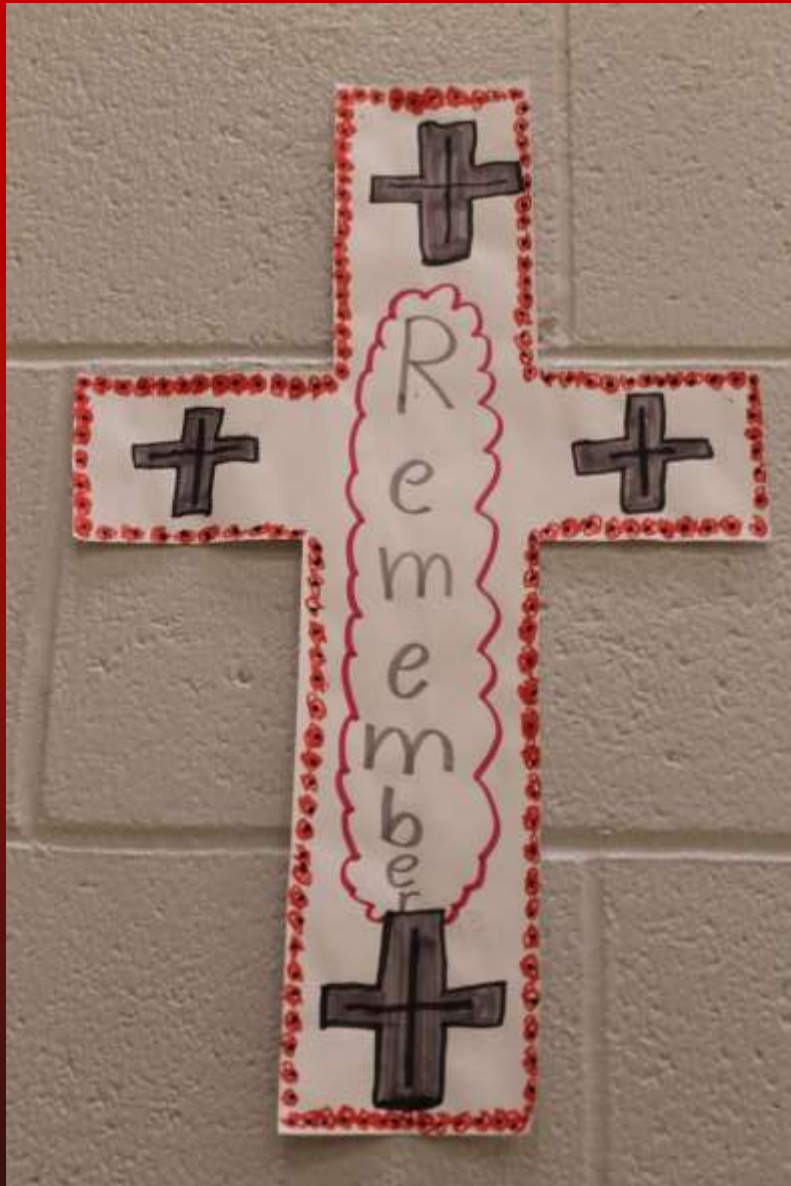
Ridge and it made me sad. We are remembering
