Pembina Hills Colony Schools Soccer Tournament Rules

Kickoff:

- Kickoffs occur at the **halfway point** on the field.
- **To start a game**, the team that is located closest to Sunny Bend will take the first kickoff. If we have a half-time break, the team farthest from Sunny Bend will take the kickoff at half.
- **After every goal**, the team who was scored on will take the kickoff.
- All opposing players must be a minimum of 15 feet from the ball until it has been put into play.
- The ball may not be touched by the kicker again until another player has contacted the ball.

Throw in:

- If the ball goes **out of bounds on the sides**, possession is given to the team who did not touch the ball last and a throw in will occur **from the point where the ball left the field**.
- The defenders must be at least 5 feet away from the ball.
- Throw in will be made with **two hands overhead and both feet in contact with the ground**. One foot may slide along the ground during a throw in.
- The ball may not be touched again by the thrower until another player has contacted the ball

Corner kick:

- If a ball goes **out of bounds on the end**, and the last person to touch the ball was the **defending team**, the **offensive team** is awarded an **indirect kick** from the **nearest corner of the field**.
- Defenders must stay at least 10 yards from the ball until the ball is kicked.

Goal kick:

- If a ball goes **out of bounds on the end**, and the last person to touch the ball was the **offensive team**, the **defensive team** is awarded an **indirect kick from inside the goalie's crease**.
- Anyone on the team may kick the ball, but the ball must be **kicked off of the ground**.

- The **goalie may not pick up the ball** with their hands if they receive a pass from a teammate.
- Defenders must stay at least 10 yards from the ball until the ball is kicked.

Handball:

- When a player **deliberately touches the ball with their hands or gains an advantage from touching the ball** with their hands, an **indirect kick** will be awarded to the opposite team, **from the point of the handball**.
- Hands are considered any part of the arm from the shoulder to the fingertips.
- Handball will **not be called** if a player is **protecting sensitive areas of their body** and they **do not gain possession** of the ball after it touches their hands.

Body Contact (tripping/pushing):

- When a player trips or pushes an opposing player, an **indirect kick will be awarded** to the opposing team, **from the point of the infraction**.
- If this **behavior is repeated**, the **coach will sit the player** for an extra shift, and if it continues, the coach may need to sit the player for the remainder of the game.

A goal may not be scored directly from a throw in or an indirect kick. Indirect kicks include a kick after a hands or body infraction, a corner kick, a goal kick, and a kickoff.

Other than goalkeepers, substitutions can be made on the fly. The player leaving the field must reach the bench before the replacement player enters the field. All substitutions can be made during stoppages in play.
