Volunteer Registration

Pembina Hills School Division requires all parents who help in classrooms, go on fieldtrips, help with hot lunches, etc to complete the Volunteer Registration process.

Step 1

Submit to the school office a completed Volunteer Registration form. A printable version of the form is available on the School Division webpage, or you can request one from the school office.

Step 2

Submit to the school office a current Criminal Record Check from the Westlock RCMP. You'll need to 1st get a letter from the office to bring with you so it will be free of charge.

Step 3

Submit to the school office a Child Intervention Check. This is available through Alberta Children's Services. To request the online form email cs.ircnorth@gov.ab.ca.

Step 4

Once all 3 items are received by the school office the Principal will review the Volunteer Registration. If all the School Division requirements are met, the registration will be approved.

Approved

The Pembina Hills Volunteer Form will need to be done each year, however the Criminal Record Check and Child Intervention Checks do not. These will remain on file, unless there is a change to the Criminal Record Check or Child Intervention Check, in which case updated copies must be provided to the school and the registration will be re-evaluated for approval by the Principal.
