

Volunteer Registration

Pembina Hills School Division requires all school volunteers to complete the Volunteer Registration process.

Step 1

Submit to the school office a completed Volunteer Registration form. A printable version of the form is available on the School Division webpage, or you can request one from the school office.

Step 2

Submit to the school office a current Criminal Record Check. These are available through the Westlock RCMP, however you must have a letter from the school saying why you need a CRC.

Step 3

Submit to the school office a Child Intervention Check. This is available through Alberta Children's Services. To request the online form email cs.ircnorth@gov.ab.ca.

Step 4

Once all 3 items are received by the school office the Principal will review the Volunteer Registration. If all the School Division requirements are met, the registration will be approved.

Approved

The approved Volunteer
Registration will be in effect
for the duration of time that
the volunteer has children at
our school. It does not need to
be done each year. If,
however, there is a change to
the Criminal Record Check or
Child Intervention Check,
updated copies must be
provided to the school and the
registration will be reevaluated for approval by the
Principal.

Alberta Health Services nurses will be at our school on Tuesday, November 25th in the afternoon to administer vaccinations to our Grade 6 students. If you haven't returned the Consent Form for this, please send it back with your Gr 6 child as soon as possible.







Staff from Safely On Board will be at our school to lead our K, 1, 2 & 4 students through bus safety lessons and activities. This program is funded by the government and provides students with important lessons to help them stay safe on the bus.

Alberta Health Services offers free flouride varnish treatments for children in PN-Prep, Kindergarten, Gr 1 & Gr 2. AHS staff will be at our school to administer the flouride treatments on December 1st and 2nd. Only students with completed Consent Forms will receive the flouride treatments.

We'll be having another free pizza lunch for our students on December 4th Students can have up to 2 slices each. Varieties offered are Cheese, Pepperoni and Hawaiian. The pizza is paid for through government School Nutrition Funding.

Preparing our Annual Christmas Feast is a huge undertaking, so volunteer help is required. Here's what we need:


 At least 4 people are needed to help with food prep and cooking at the Jarvie Community Center (Andrea will let you know the day and start time).














Thank you
