



Volunteer Registration

Pembina Hills School Division requires all school volunteers to complete the Volunteer Registration process.

Step 1

Submit to the school office a completed Volunteer Registration form. A printable version of the form is available on the School Division webpage, or you can request one from the school office.

Step 2

Submit to the school office a current Criminal Record Check. These are available through the Westlock RCMP, however you must have a letter from the school saying why you need a CRC.

Step 3

Submit to the school office a Child Intervention Check. This is available through Alberta Children's Services. To request the online form email cs.ircnorth@gov.ab.ca.

Step 4

Once all 3 items are received by the school office the Principal will review the Volunteer Registration. If all the School Division requirements are met, the registration will be approved.

Approved

The approved Volunteer Registration will remain on file throughout the school year. The Division Volunteer Registration Form must be completed each year. If there is no change to the Criminal Record Check or Child Intervention Check the original copies will be kept on file. If there have been changes to these, updated copies must be provided to the school and the registration will be re-evaluated for approval by the Principal.



Our Grade 2 & 3 classes are going on a field trip on March 26. They will be tubing at Tawatinaw Ski Hill and then head over to the Pine Valley Gymnastics Centre for the afternoon. Their bus leaves at 9:00 am and returns by 3:30 pm. Please complete the Consent Forms in Powerschool.
